B. The parties have agreed to vary the Agreement on the terms and conditions set out in this variation agreement (the Variation).

TERMS

1. Definition

- 1.1 In this Variation, unless the context requires otherwise:
 - a. words and expressions have the meanings given to them in the Agreement and the Definitions clause applies to this Variation; and
 - b. references to clauses and schedules are to the clauses and the schedules of the Agreement.

2. Variation

2.1 With effect on and from the date on which this Variation is signed by both parties (the **Effective Date**), the Agreement is varied as follows:

Schedule 1 - Summary - Overview

- a. The end date of the contract is extended from 30 June 2023 to 30 March 2024.
- 2.2 Subject to clause 2.1, all other terms and conditions contained in the Agreement will continue in full force and effect.

3. Governing law

3.1 This Variation is governed by New Zealand law and the parties submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the New Zealand Courts.

4. Counterparts

4.1 This Variation may be executed in any number of counterparts (including electronic copies), each of which will be deemed an original, but all of which together constitute one instrument. No counterpart is effective until each party has executed at least one counterpart.
